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### Itinerary Belize central and south region

**Day 1: Bluefield Range** After a warm welcome, orientation, and safety briefing, we set sail for the Bluefield Range. Begin the afternoon with your first dive into the Caribbean Sea—an immersive introduction to Belize's coastal waters. Back on board, enjoy some relaxed casting from the boat while taking in the surrounding scenery. These nutrient-rich waters, influenced by nearby mangroves, support a vibrant marine ecosystem. As evening approaches, unwind on deck with a cocktail in hand and take in a classic Caribbean sunset before dinner under the stars.

**Day 2: Sailing to Tobacco Caye** As the sun rises over the barrier reef, enjoy your breakfast while we sail south to Tobacco Caye. This 5-acre, palm-fringed coral island is perched right on the reef, offering a great place to snorkel or dive directly from the shore. Let us take you by boat to some of the best hidden snorkel sites in Belize, all within 10 minutes of the island. Later, unwind at a tiny, laid-back beach bar with a fresh coconut water or an icy rum cocktail, and learn about remote island life from the 39 local islanders who call this "rock" their home.

**Day 3: North Long Cocoa Caye** Today, your skipper charts a course for North Long Cocoa, a true fisherman and snorkeler's mecca. Experience a stunning maze of sandbars and coral reefs tucked between deep blue channels. This is the perfect spot for an al-fresco lunch under a traditional palapa structure over the water. With not a soul to be seen for miles around, you can truly soak in the tranquility of the Caribbean.

**Day 4: The Hidden Pelican Cayes** This hidden collection of mangrove islands is surrounded by the most impressive coral heads in the country. Dive into the water to witness incredible marine life or take a paddleboard out for a spin in the calm, protected spots. We will make a fun pit stop at "Hideaway Caye"—a tiny, eco-friendly bar hidden in the mangroves that runs entirely on solar power. It's a true "blink and you'll miss it" gem!

**Day 5: The "Aquarium" and South Water Caye** We journey a short distance to snorkel at Carrie Bow Caye, affectionately known as "The Aquarium" for its density of fish. Time permitting, let us assist you in visiting the Smithsonian Institute Field Station to learn about coral reef conservation. Later, we sail to South Water Caye, a pristine and exclusive 12-acre private island. As the fishermen return with their catch, head to the Blue Marlin Lodge for an icy Belikin beer and a game of billiards while watching the pelicans gather.

**Day 6: Rendezvous Caye** Rendezvous Caye is a tiny, postcard-perfect island located right on the barrier reef. Your yacht will anchor here so you can enjoy a beach picnic or lounge in a hammock. Experience the thrill of snorkeling along the deep-water wall right from the shore. Keep an eye out for graceful spotted eagle rays; they often visit the boats to see what the catch of the day is!

**Day 7: Goff's Caye and the Manatees** We sail to Goff's Caye—an island that reminds us exactly why postcards were invented. Relax on the sandbar with a cold drink or snorkel straight from the white sand beach. Afterward, we sail to Bannister Bogue, a nature lover's paradise. These islands are home to dolphins and the gentle West Indian Manatee. While a sighting is never guaranteed, these "sea cows" are a majestic sight to behold in their natural habitat.

**Day 8: Beautiful Goodbyes** Enjoy a final, leisurely sail back to the marina at Old Belize. We are sorry to see you go, but we are confident the magic of the reef will bring you back to these turquoise waters again soon!
